
Apparatus

* Millivolt Input	0-10 to 0.1000 millivolts
Record	Single or double pen continuous line and coloured dots or symbols
Standardization Chart	Continuous automatic (Zener diode) 9-7/9 and 10 <sup>#</sup> / inches calibrated width
Pen Speed	1 second to 30 seconds
Printing interval	1/4 seconds to 60 seconds
Chart speed	3/4 inch per hour minimum
Power supply	120 volts 60 cycles
Max. external resistance	2000 ohms
Approved amplifiers	3620-1, R-32-1-1 and 101103 transistor type

- \* The kilowatts, megawatts or other power function which the millivolts represent will be shown on the nameplate, scale and range card.
- x L.H. zero and raised zero up to half scale is approved except for recorders having a retransmitting function which are not approved with a raised zero.
- o Pen speed is the time taken for the pen or printing mechanism to travel the full length of the scale with a step load change equal to full scale.
- # When a 10 inch calibrated width chart is used, the pen or printing mechanism must be adjusted for a live zero, the pen or print is then prevented by a mechanical stop from reaching full scale.
- ø Printing interval is the time between successive prints.

Description

This circular supersedes and consolidates previous circulars SD-EA.182, SD-EA.402, SD-EA.407, S-EA.430, S-EA.445, S-EA.592 and S-EA.633. It includes a number of optional features and their identifying suffixes, all of which covered by this approval.

The suffix "036" indicates that a door lock for use by the Utility has been provided to eliminate the need for sealing the adjustments. Door locks are standard equipment on all Speedomax G recorders.

The suffix "SL" indicates a zero checking switch. This shorts the input allowing the pen to return to zero.
