
Re: Approval of Canadian General Electric

This is to advise you that the National Research Council has approved for use in Canada the 60-cycle, 25-ampere, types "I-30A" and "I-30S" watt-hour meters, manufactured by the Canadian General Electric Company, Toronto, Ontario.

This circular is to supplement circulars N.R.C. 104, dated October 28, 1937, and N.R.C. 123, dated July 27, 1939, and I would suggest that on these two circulars, you enter "25" between "15" and "50" in the information relating to amperes.
