Dear Sirs:

It is to advise that special approval has been granted by the Standards Authority for the use of the following equipment to one only of the 110 kV, 100/100.0 MVA, 50/50 Hz, 110/110 kV, 60 cycle, 3 phase, 3 wire outdoor oil insulated switching equipment serial number S-70001.

This outfit consists of three 110/110 kV oil immersed transformers that are connected in a delta-delta configuration. The serial number of the transformers being numbers S-70001, S-70002 and S-70003.

The approximate load capacity is 0.55 or 0.56 for the voltage transformers and 0.55.0 for the current transformers.

This equipment is for the initial design Electrical Company Limited for installation at St. John's, Edinburgh.
