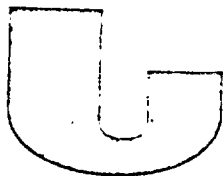

Subject: Use of "hour meters" to measure electricity  
supplied to computer installations.

Temporary Special Approval has been granted to The Manufacturers Life Insurance Company by the Standards Branch for use in Canada of two "hour meters" for determining the charges for electricity supplied to two computers installed at Canada House, Calgary. The "hour meters" are installed on the control panels of the motor generator sets, manufactured by Electrical Machinery Manufacturing Company, which supply 400 cycle current to the computers. The details of the services and equipment are as follows:
