Special Approval has been granted by the Standards Branch for use in Canada for billing purposes to the above-named apparatus.

These transformers are post type with a 2-section primary windings that can be connected in series or parallel; and 2 tapped secondary windings, the latter identified as "X" and "Y".

Only the "X" winding is approved for revenue metering as follows:
