MODIFICATION TO SPRAGUE TYPES 175, 240 and 250 STANDARD AND TEMPERATURE COMPENSATED POSITIVE DISPLACEMENT GAS METERS

Approval Circular G-43, dated March 5, 1969 remains in force

## DESCRIPTION

Circular G-43 contains illustrations showing the meter register covered by a metal index box assembly.

The manufacturer has recently introduced wholly Polycarbonate Index Boxes to cover the registers in these meters and added steel inset hubs to meter connections in slightly revised design of the top casting.

Thes modifications do not affect the performance of these meters and they have been approved.
