Internal Modifications to Sprague Meter Division,
Types 175, 240 and 250 Standard and Temperature
Compensated Positive Displacement Gas Meters

Approval Circulars G-43-2, G-43-1 and G-43 remain in
force.

Description

The modifications involve:

(1) Mounting the "index driving movement" (IDM) precisely on the top of the meter cover casting with the output shaft through the front with a boot seal. This IDM is glass filled nylon with a nylon gear and acetal worm gear. The drive shaft is stainless steel.

The original meters have the IDM threaded through the front of the top casting.


Refer to the attached photographs for a clear illustration of this change.

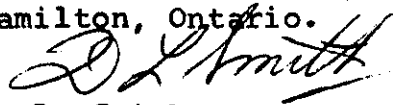
(2) The centre bracket of the main movement assembly now has a boot seal that holds grease to ensure a positive seal between the bracket and its shaft.

The original meters have a blind valve on the top of the bracket that must be greased to create this seal.

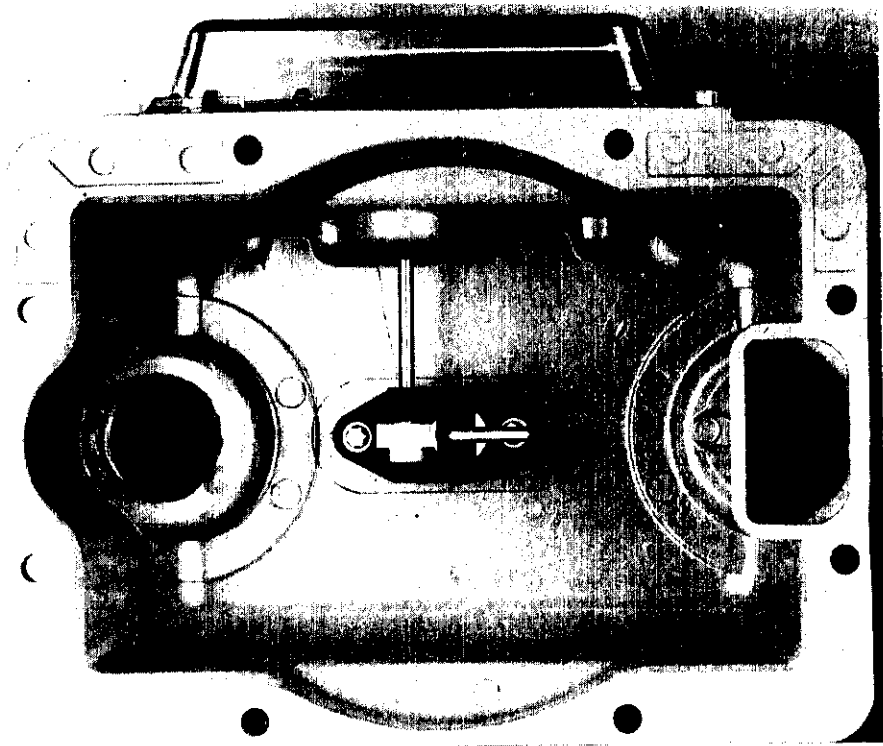

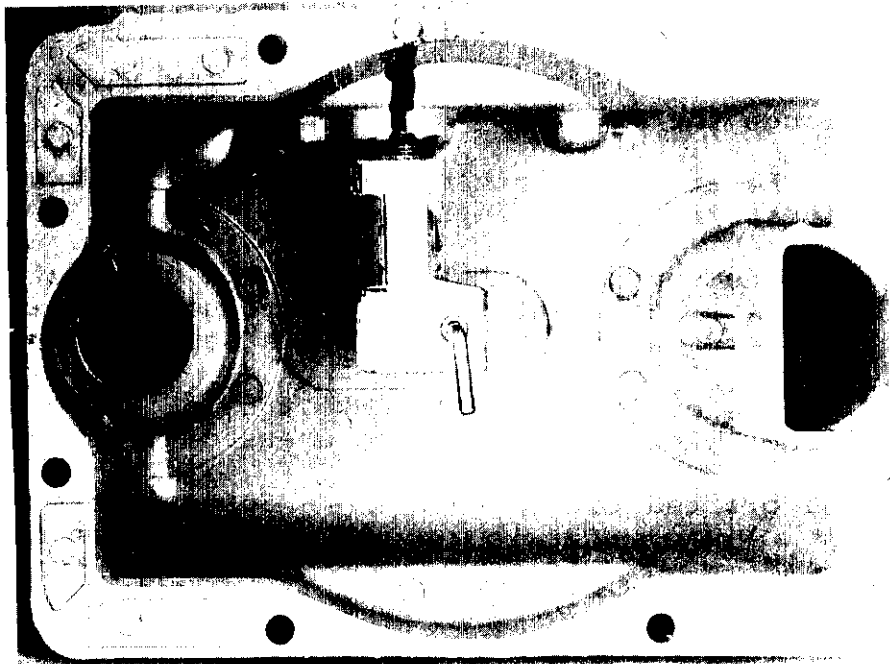
