Temporary special approval has been granted by the Standards Branch to Canadian Western Natural Gas Company Limited, to apply a pressure factor in the measurement of gas at the following installation under the stated conditions:

Customer - Mr. Jacob Stocker  
 Address - 444-14th Avenue Northwest, Alberta.  
 Nature of Load - Farmstead - 2 residences, garage, hog barn,  
 root cellar.

Load - 1,095 c.f.h.  
 Service line pressure - 30 p.s.i.  
 Metering pressure - 10 p.s.i.  
 Upstream Regulator - Fisher 1" 691-5 3/16" orifice  
 meter - 355 - 15 p.s.i. W.P.  
 Relief valve - between regulator and meter - 1" Fisher 289H  
 set at 12 p.s.i.  
 Atmospheric Pressure - 13.00 p.s.i.  
 Pressure correction factor -  $\frac{13.0 + 10.0}{13.25} = 1.730$
