## NOTIFICATION OF TYPE LISTING

Under the provisions of the appropriate Act the apparatus specified and illustrated herein have been listed as Class A devices, and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions stated herein.

Authority: Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 212, R.S. 1927, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 3459).

Apparatus Listed: Models 1160 and 1170 Pre-packaging scales, manufactured by Toledo Scale Company of Canada, Limited, Windsor, Ont.

Rating of Apparatus: 15 lbs. maximum capacity.

Application: Weighing of commodities for pre-packaging purposes.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 3459 with the added mandatory requirement that these scales shall not be used on the retail premises of any business enterprise.

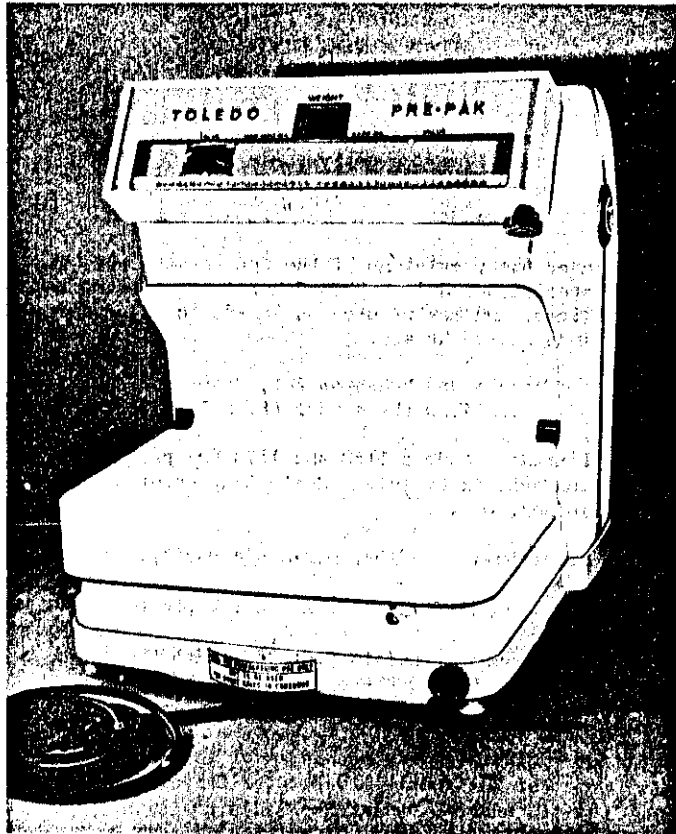
Description: The weighing mechanism of these scales is similar to that of the Model 1110 Counter-Computing-Platform Scale listed under Circular SD-WA.23 (Revision - 1), dated February 25th, 1949, except that it has no zero adjustment on the main lever. The scales are equipped with an indicating scroll for price selection and a detachable, manual knob for tare adjustment. The chart is visible on the user's side only and is arranged for horizontal reading on the Model 1160 and for angular reading on the Model 1170.

Testing: The standard tests for a Counter-Computing-Platform Cylindrical Chart Scale will apply and the tare adjustment should be tested to make certain that no change in the tare can be effected except by actually turning the knob.
