NOTIFICATION OF TYPE LISTING

Under the provisions of the appropriate Act the apparatus specified and illustrated herein has been listed as a Class A device, and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable to this classification.

Authority: Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 212, R.S. 1927, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 3459).

Apparatus Listed: Model 1420 counter-computing-fan chart scale, manufactured by Berkel Products Company Limited, Toronto, Ontario.

Rating of Apparatus: 15 $\frac{1}{4}$ lbs. maximum capacity, with 0 to 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ lbs. on the chart.

Application: Weighing of commodities in general trade.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 3459.

Description: The scale is an equal arm computing scale, the chart having a capacity of 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ lbs. and is graduated in $\frac{1}{4}$ ounces, 14 lbs. of weights are also supplied.

The scale is similar in general design to Model 2N listed on SD-WA.41.

The mechanism is designed on the equal arm principle, combined with a lever and pendulum action.

The main bearings are agate and the pivots of hardened steel of the knife edge type.

Money values show on the Vendor's side of the chart and weight only on the Customer's side. The device is equipped with levelling feet and level, and is finished in white enamel.

Testing: The standard tests for a counter-computing-fan chart scale will apply.
