NOTIFICATION OF TYPE LISTING

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 36, S.C. 1951, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein have been listed as approved devices and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: Overhead Monorail Track Scale, Models 1342, 1344, 1346, and 1348 equipped with beam, also included are catalogue numbers, as follows:

1342TC, 1344TC, 1346TC, and 1348TC equipped with pedestal dial;

1342S, 1344S, 1346S, and 1348S equipped with tall column weightograph;

1342W, 1344W, 1346W, and 1348W equipped with beam and 1/1700 weightograph;

1342CD, 1344CD, 1346CD, and 1348CD equipped with cabinet dial;

1342CW, 1344CW, 1346CW, and 1348CW equipped with cabinet dial;

manufactured by the Howe Scale Company, Rutland, Vermont, U.S.A.

Rating of Apparatus: The capacities range from 600 lbs. to 3300 lbs., depending on the model and registering equipment.

Application: Weighing of merchandise such as animal carcasses suspended from an overhead track.

Description: This device is an overhead track scale whose load receiving track forms a section of an overhead conveyor system. The leverage system consists of two main A type levers and a cut-off lever, except in the case of Model 1348 which has two L type main levers with a track ceiling clearance of 8"; whereas, the track ceiling clearance for the other three models is 23". Pivots are hardened, the bearings are self-aligning and the scale is suspended generally from the ceiling. The means of registering is as stated above.

Testing: The standard tests for an overhead monorail track scale shall apply.

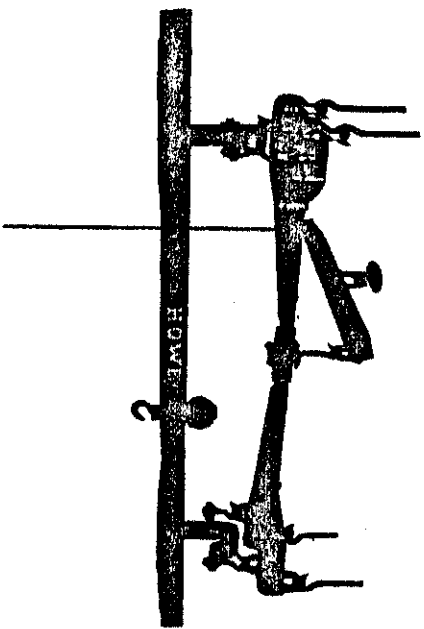
