## NOTIFICATION OF TYPE LISTING

Vehicle Scale - Manufactured by the Winslow  
Government Standard Scale Works, 25th and  
Haythorne Avenues, Terre Haute, Indiana, U.S.A.

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter  
36, S.C. 1951, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus  
specified and illustrated herein has been listed as an approved device  
and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: Vehicle Scale Four-Section Type S, Model 1000,  
equipped with Model C.D., T.R.A., or T.R.B. weighbeams.

Rating of Apparatus: 100,000 lbs.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894, with the specific condition  
that the minimum graduation must not represent more than  
20 lbs.

Description: This device is a 4 section scale whose components  
are similar in design to the type S two-section scale  
illustrated on Circular SD-WA.167, except that it is  
equipped with 4 main levers and the necessary extension  
levers have been added.

The registering devices with which this scale may  
be equipped are of the same designs as are depicted  
on Approval Circulars SD-WA.67, 69, and 70, except that  
the capacity is greater. The various platform sizes are  
45' x 10', 50' x 10', and 60' x 10'.

The weighbridge may be constructed to support either  
a wood or concrete deck.

Testing: The standard tests for a 4 section vehicle scale shall  
apply.
