Wire Meter - Manufactured by
Olympic Instrument Laboratories, Cove,
Washington, U. S. A.

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C.6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein have been listed as approved devices and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: Linear wire measuring machine, models # 220, 220-293, 220-358.


Rating of Apparatus: 250 feet per minute.


Application: Linear measuring of wire, hose and other flexible material to 1" diameter in trade.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894. The meters may be marked with the trade name "Hykon" or "Olympic".

Description: This device consists of two metal drums, one is an idler under spring tension and the other is a measuring drum geared to indicators. As the wire or other material is drawn between the drums three indicators register the measurement of the product in feet, tens of feet and hundreds of feet. The device is supplied with an inlet guide and a manually operated spring tension release mechanism.
Model 220-293 is fitted with a side opening to accommodate flat material and model 220-358 is equipped to measure twin welding hose. The registering dials are friction type and may be returned to zero by hand.

Testing: The standard tests for a drum type linear measuring device shall apply.
