## APPROVAL LISTING

SANITARY COMPUTING COUNTER SCALE  
TYPE V-10

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act., Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein have been listed as approved devices, and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: Cylinder computing counter scale type V-10, Models 18-A-60, 18-A-80, 18-A-170, 18-S-170, 24-A-80, 24-S-80, 24-A-103, 24-S-103, 24-A-125, 24-S-125, 24-A-90, 24-S-90, 24-A-129, 24-S-129, 30-A-60, 30-A-80 and 30-S-80, manufactured by the Sanitary Scale Company, Belvidere, Illinois, U.S.A.

Rating of Apparatus: 18 lb., 24 lb. and 30 lb. capacities.

Application: Weighing commodities in retail trade.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894.

Description: These devices are counter computing scales with cylindrical computing charts. The scales are identical to the V-10 type listed on SD-WA.16 except that the model numbers have been changed and additional charts with different price per pound ranges have been provided.

The model number consists of: (1) The capacity of the scale, (2) A letter indicating that the scale is straight read or angle read, (3) The maximum price per pound.

Testing: The Standard tests for a computing counter scale shall apply.
