Types LV-4F, LV-4, LVH-4F and LVH-2 capacity 4" Maximum Diameter. Manufactured by Entwistle Manufacturing Corporation, 1475 Elmwood Avenue., Providence 7, Rhode Island, U.S.A.


Application: Wholesale trade and industrial use.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894.

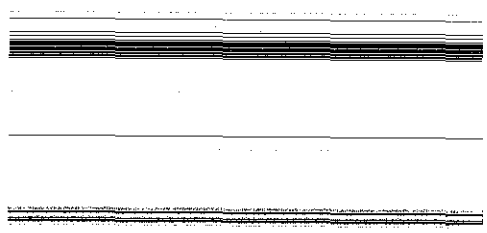
Description: These devices are wire measuring machines equipped with three measuring wheels geared to a gear system which transmits their motion to a spur gear which drives the counters. The measuring wheels automatically adjust themselves to various diameters within their capacities. The machines may be equipped with individual delivery counters or also have a totalizer counter in addition and may be equipped with types of measuring wheels to suit the material measured.

Testing: The standard tests for a linear measuring machine shall apply.

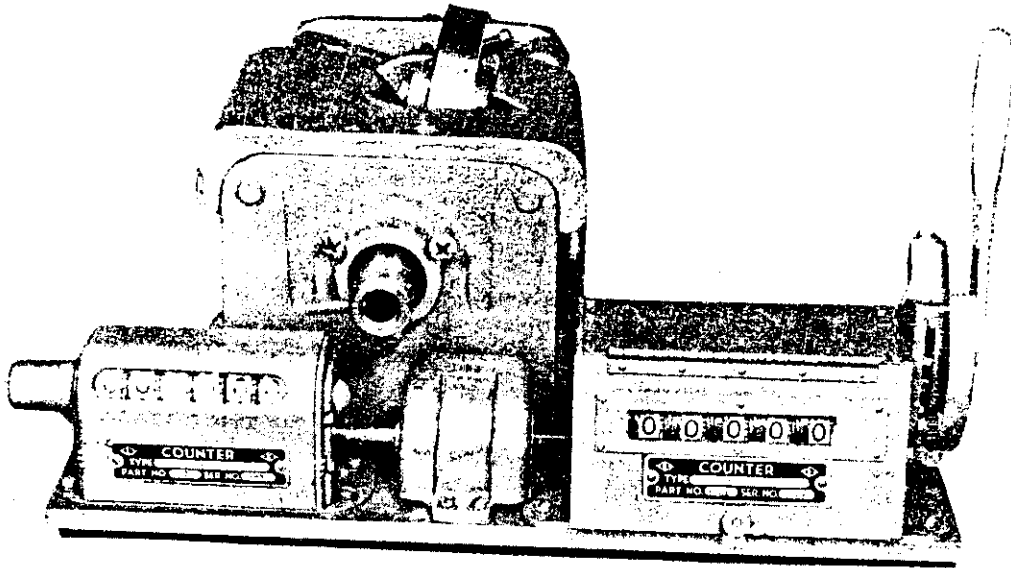

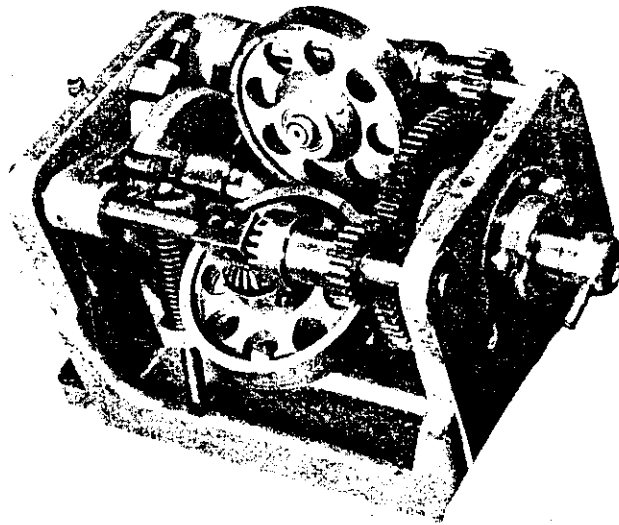
