FAIRBANKS - MORSE PORTABLE ROAD CONTRACTOR'S SCALE

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein has been listed as an approved device and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.


Apparatus Listed: Trailer type road contractor's vehicle scale models 6504-P, 6507-P and 6509-P with capacities of 20 tons, 30 tons and 50 tons respectively, manufactured by Canadian Fairbanks-Morse Company Limited, 350 Belvidere Street, Sherbrooke, Quebec. Executive offices, 980 St. Antoine Street, Montreal 3, Quebec.


Application: Weighing construction material.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894 with the added requirements that the use of the scale in any one location shall be of a temporary nature and the foundation on location to be such that the scale remains level when in use.

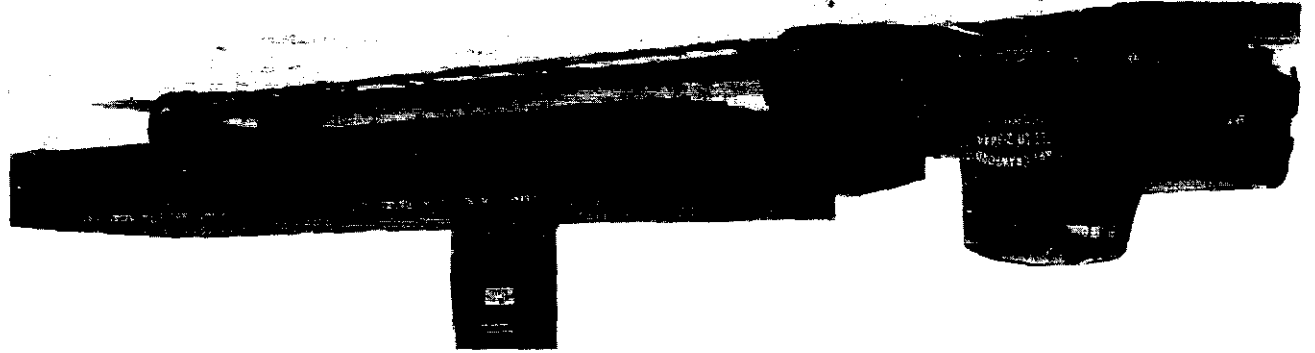
Description: This device is a heavy duty type S contractor's portable scale expressly built to be towed by a power unit to a temporary location. The leverage systems of these scales are identical to the vehicles scales listed on SD-WA.342 except for the transverse lever arrangement. The transfer lever is designed to permit the removal of the up-pull extension lever to prepare the scales for transit. The scales may be equipped with F-M double bar beam or type registering beam. The leverage system is contained within a fabricated steel frame.

Testing: The standard tests for a motor truck scale shall apply.
