Type of Device -

Compudraft Series 1000 Full Electronic Bulk Grain Weighing System. This system consists of the instrumentation which is used to control the weighing and handling of grain in a terminal transfer situation. The instrument itself may form part of a system including printers, control devices (solenoids, gates, motors, etc.) and digital computer. The inputs to the device are weight signals from load cells and control signals from hopper sensors and gate solenoids.

Conditions of Approval:

1. This approval covers the following installations -
 - a) 6 units in Calgary (Canadian Gov't Elevator)
 - b) 8 units in Churchill, Manitoba (National Harbours Board)
 - c) 14 units at Elevator #5 at National Harbours Board in Montreal Harbour. These units include CRT's man. by Intelligence Systems Incorporated. They are designated as series 1000C units.
