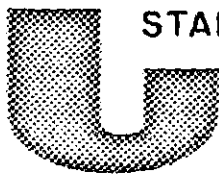

Application: This printer is approved for use on all approved models of Stathmos and Stathmos-Lindell scales to which it is adaptable.

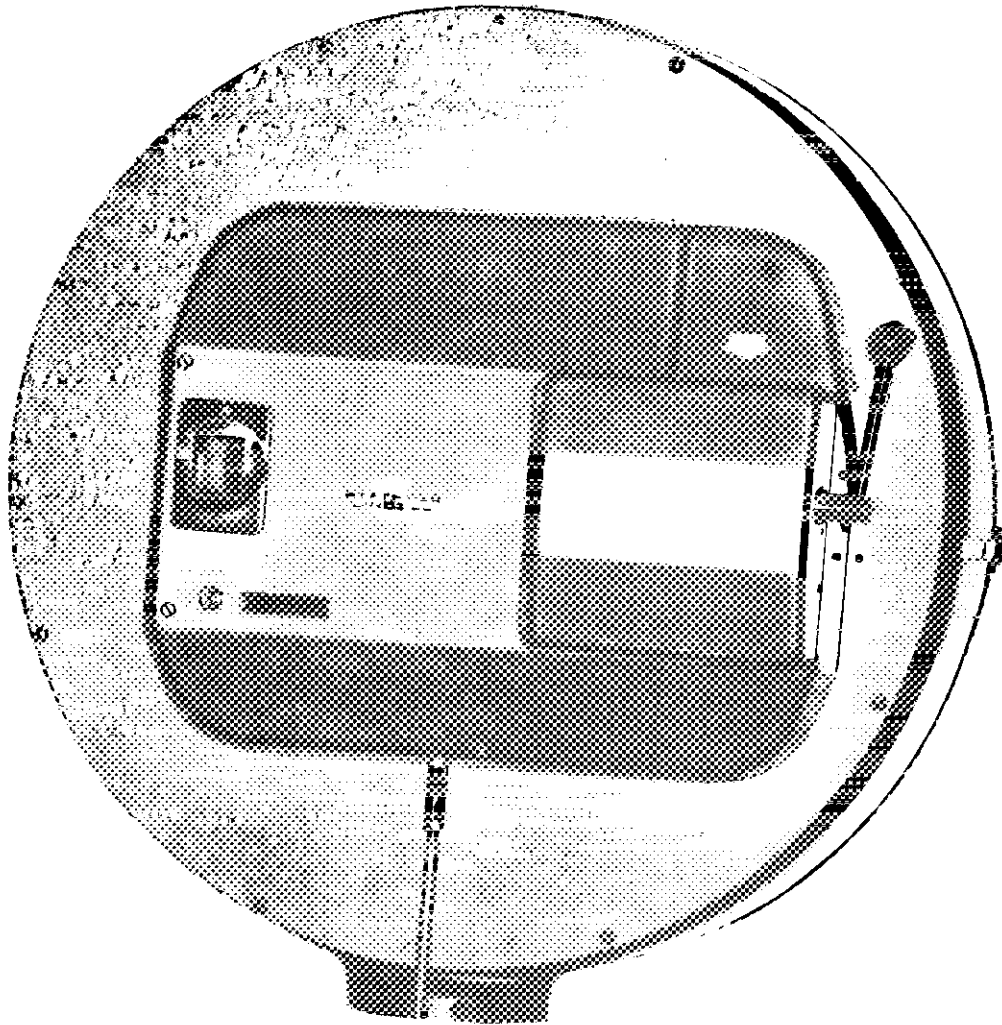
Description: This printer utilizes a type wheel carrying the same graduations as the scale dial and mounted on the dial indicator shaft. A stationary indicating arrow is located adjacent to the type wheel. An inked ribbon serves the printing function. An impression is obtained by operating a handle which brings the weight ticket into contact with the inked ribbon and the type wheel.

The printed ticket records several weight graduations with the indicating showing the actual weight. This weight indication is the same as the dial indication whether or not unit weights are being used. The value of unit weights, when applicable shown as a separate printing on the weight ticket, e.g. "Add 1000", "Add 2000", etc.

Weight indication can be read through a magnifying lens at the rear of the printer housing.
