Type of Device

Apparatus:

Computing Parcel Post Scale - Model 779.

Rating:

Maximum capacity - 40 pounds x 1 ounce
18 kilograms x 50 grams

Metric graduation shall be clearly identified and coloured red.

Application:

Parcel weighing and the determination of postal charges.


Description:

This device is a fan-type parcel post counter scale with a hairline indicator actuated by a cam and pendulum assembly. The leverage system is of the cast iron single lever type, the pivots are of tool steel with turned shanks which are a press fit into reamed holes in the lever. The bearings are V-type tool steel self-aligning. The chart is printed with both weight and money values based on the parcel post rates. The scale is equipped with a single stainless steel notched beam.

The scale base and chart housing are of cast construction with painted finish. The commodity platter is of rectangular stainless steel.

Testing:

The standard tests for computing counter scales shall apply.
