Apparatus: Computing Counter Scale, with selective
avoirdupois or metric indication.

Model: Autometric

Rating: Avoirdupois - 3 pounds
Metric - 1.5 kilograms

Application: The weighing of commodities in trade.

Description: This scale utilizes a single load lever of cast
construction. Load is resisted by means of three helical
springs.

By the use of a selector tool, either an
avoirdupois chart or a metric weight chart may be brought
into view. The operation of the selector tool also acts to
adjust the active length, and hence the rate, of one of the
load resistance springs, so that full capacity indicator
travel remains the same, whichever weighing units are selected.

The price chart is unchanged between the
two systems of weighing units, except that the legend "Price
per Pound" or "Price per 500g" comes into view for avoirdupois
and for metric respectively.

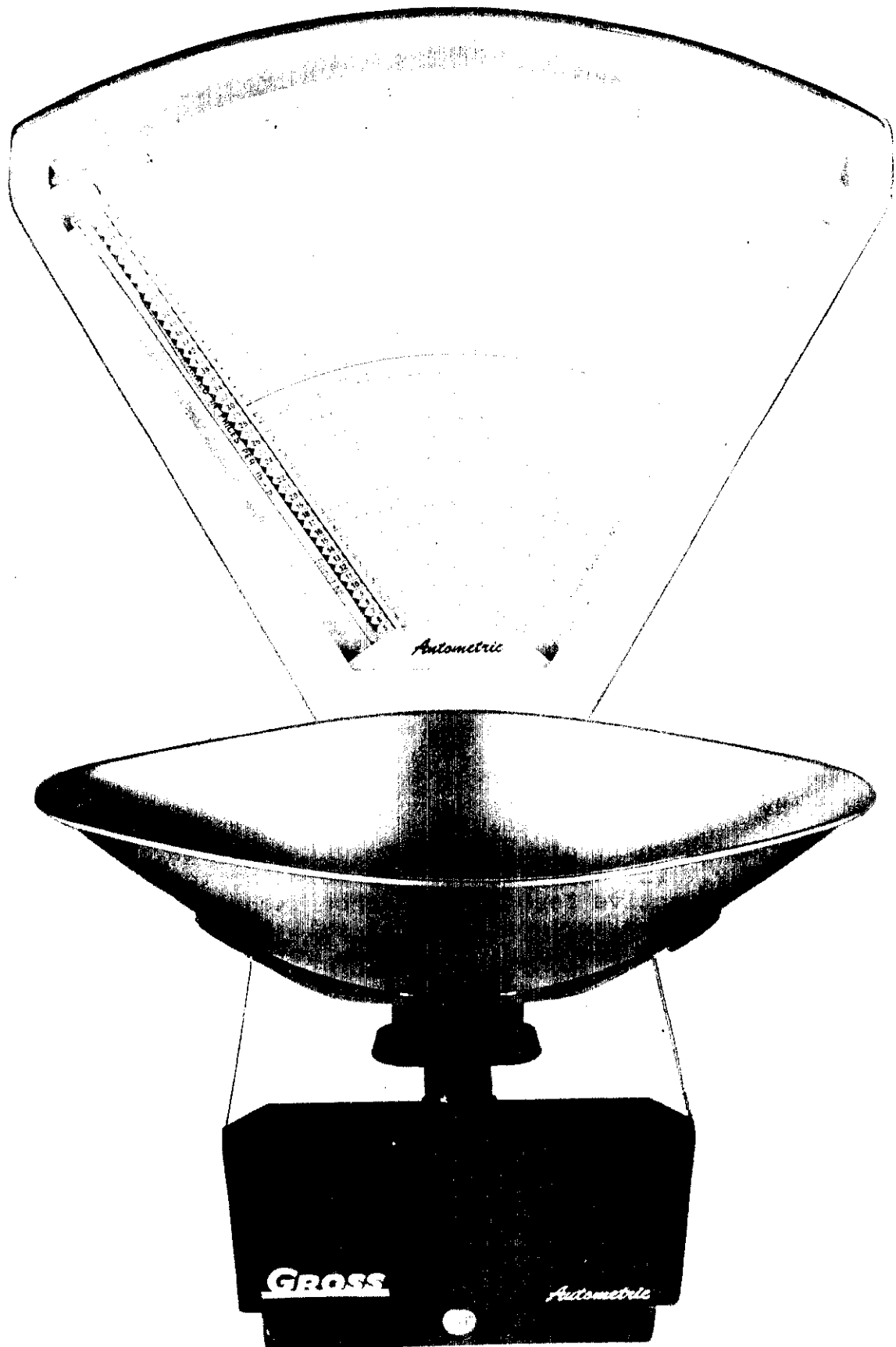
The scale base and dial housings are of cast
aluminum. The lever system enclosure is of pressed sheet steel.
The load receiver is a stainless steel scoop.
