## NOTIFICATION OF TYPE LISTING

Under the provisions of the appropriate Act, the apparatus specified and illustrated herein have been listed as approved devices and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Authority: Chapter 36, S.C. 1951 and Regulations thereunder (P.C.6894).

Apparatus Listed: (1) Tank Wagon Measures.  
(2) Oil Delivery Measures. - Both types manufactured by General Steelwares Limited, Montreal, P.Q.

Rating of Apparatus: 5 gallons capacity.


Application: Measuring and carrying liquid commodities, particularly in the petroleum trade.


Conditions: These measures have been approved on a prototype basis and do not require original inspection before sale; provided that the words "LEGAL FOR TRADE" are marked on the measures in accordance with regulations, P.C.6894.

Description: The tank wagon measure has a body constructed of heavy gauge corrugated galvanized steel plate. The breast joining the body to the neck is of curved construction. The neck of the measure is completely surrounded by a pouring lip, a portion of it being covered by an anti-splash plate. A wire of .15" diameter is located within the neck and acts as a gauging mark. The measure is equipped with a flat bail handle.

Oil delivery measures have a body similarly constructed to the foregoing description. The breasts of both measures are also similar. The neck of the oil delivery measure has no pouring lip and gauging is from the bottom of the neck. The measure is equipped with a bail type handle of heavy gauge wire and is provided with a cover.

Testing: The standard tests for a Static Volumetric measure shall apply.
