Gasoline dispensers, Manufactured by  
Erie Meter Systems, Inc., Erie, Pa., U.S.A.

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein have been listed as approved devices and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: Gasoline dispensing retail meter pumps, computing models, 771-16, and 777-16, and non-computing models 991-16, and 999-16.

Rating: 10 G.P.M.

Application: Retail gasoline trade.


Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894.


Description: These devices are gasoline dispensing meter pumps with the same major components and general design as Model 743-16 (SD-WA.252). The models listed differ from model 743-16 as follows:-

- (1) Sight glasses are located above the register and not on the end of the cabinet.
- (2) The length and means of suspension of the hose is different.
- (3) Models 991-16 and 777-16 are tall cabinet types and Models 999-16 and 771-16 are low cabinet types.
- (4) The cabinet glass panels are longer and in one piece.
- (5) Lighting outlets are located differently.

The pumping unit is located in the cabinet adjacent to the meter.

Testing: The standard tests for a retail meter pump shall apply.
