Gasoline dispenser - manufactured by
Gilbert-Barker, 64 Jefferson Avenue, Toronto, Ont.

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C.6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein has been listed as an approved device and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: Computing gasoline dispenser with remote pumping unit, model 1006 R.C. Remote pumping units, models RCP-1, RCP-2, RCP/3 and MSP32B-4.

Rating of Apparatus: Maximum capacity 11 G.P.M.

Application: Dispensing gasoline in retail trade.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C.6894.

Description: This device is a gasoline dispenser with the pumping unit located near the storage tank or immersed in the tank in the case of the submerged turbine pump. The casing, means of retracting the hose, counting head and meter are identical to C1006, SD-WA.258. The selection of remote pumping units which may be used with this dispenser is the same as listed on SD-WA.243.

Testing: The Standard tests for a computing gasoline dispenser shall apply.
