Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P. C. 6894), the  
apparatus specified and illustrated herein have been listed as approved  
devices and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

**Apparatus Listed:** Twin computing gasoline dispensers with remote pumping  
units, models C1016RC (one product dispenser) and C1026RC (Two  
product dispenser). Remote pumping units, models RCPI, RCPR,  
RCPS or turbine pump STP-2CS.


**Rating:** Maximum capacity 12 G.P.M.


**Application:** Dispensing gasoline in retail trade.

**Conditions:** As prescribed in P.C. 6894.

**Description:** These devices are twin gasoline dispensers installed within  
a single frame and casing. The computing head and meter are  
identical with those installed in model C1016 and C1026  
(SD-WA. 303) and the external appearance is the same.  
These dispensers have the pumping unit located near the  
source of supply except when a turbine pump is used and is  
submerged in the storage tank. Interlock control and pumping  
units are similar to those used on dispensers listed on  
circular (SD-WA. 293).

**Testing:** The standard tests for a retail gasoline dispenser shall apply.
