Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein have been listed as approved devices and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: Computing and non-computing gasoline dispensers.

Complete with pump and motor

Computing models: 1056, 1066, 1066D, 1076, 1076D, 1086 and 1086D.
Non-computing models: 1057, 1067, 1077 and 1087.

With remote pumping unit

Computing models: 1052, 1062, 1072 and 1082.
Non-computing models: 1053, 1063 and 1073.
Manufactured by: John Wood Company Limited, 101 Hanson Street,
Toronto, Ontario.

Rating of Apparatus: Maximum flow 12 G.P.M. to 20 G.P.M. depending on the motor installed.

Application: Retail gasoline trade.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894.

Description: These devices are basically similar in design and components to the 900 series dispensers listed on SD-WA.243 and SD-WA.199 with exceptions as follows:

- (1) The interlocking system has been simplified,
- (2) two visiglasses have been replaced by one protruding type,
- (3) minor changes in the design of the dispenser casing.

Testing: The standard tests for a gasoline dispenser shall apply.


