Rating of Apparatus: Maximum 15 gpm.


Indication: Dispensing gasoline in retail trade.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894.

Description: These dispensers use the same main components as in previously approved SD-WA.258, SD-WA.293 and SD-WA.384. The housing is different, the visigauge has been redesigned, and the interlock improved. The motor switch is now operated by a cam on the main control lever.

Testing: The standard tests for a gasoline dispenser shall apply.

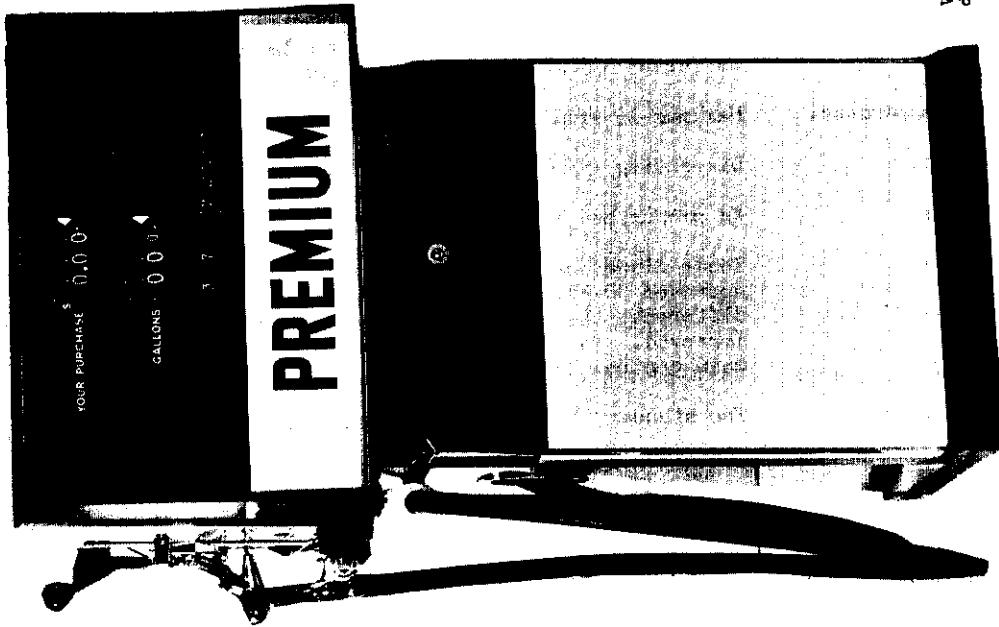
