Sangamo Type "ED30" Polyphase Demand-Energy Meters

This is to advise that approval has been granted by the Standards Branch to the Sangamo type "ED30" $2\frac{1}{2}$ -element wye horizontal polyphase demand-energy meter with 240-volt voltage coils for use on a 240/416 volt 4-wire wye service.

As this approval covers all the current ranges presently listed on Circular E-36 of May 10, 1966 under the $2\frac{1}{2}$ -Element Wye design, will you please add "240" to the 120 and 345 voltages already shown. This change is to be made on all copies of the circular in your possession.

Also on this circular are two typographical errors. The first is on the 'Current Ranges' line of the $2\frac{1}{2}$ -Element Wye where 5-40 should read ".5-40"; and the second is on the 'Current Ranges' line of the $2\frac{1}{2}$ -Element Delta where 5-37.5 should read ".5-37.5". Will you please make these corrections on all your copies.
