## TYPE APPROVAL

## FERRANTI TYPES "FMA" AND "FMS" SINGLE-PHASE WATTHOUR METERS

The apparatus specified herein has been duly approved by the Standards Division under the provisions of the Electricity Inspection Act, Chapter 94, R.S. 1952, and may be admitted to verification in Canada.

Apparatus Approved: Types "FMA" and "FMS" Single-Phase Watthour Meters, manufactured by Ferranti Electric Limited, Toronto, Ontario.

Rating of Apparatus:

Nominal Amperes ...... 5, 10, 15, 25, 50

Maximum Amperes ...... 20, 40, 60, 100, 100

Volts ...... 120, 240

Wire ...... 2, 3, 2/3 (in 15 & 25 amperes)

Frequency ...... 25, 60 cycles

Description: These meters are exactly the same as the types "FM.A" and "FMS" approved by earlier circulars except that the nameplates are stamped with the 120- or 240-volt ratings. This approval permits the use of either the 115, 230 volt nameplates or the 120, 240 volt nameplates. Pertinent circulars are:-
