Approval of Canadian BVI-CI

Two minor discrepancies in our documents pertaining to this approval should perhaps be noted since they may prompt questions from the field at some later date:

- (i) in my Circular Letter, dated September 27, 1973 (No. 601) it is stated that the new version of the BVI-CI, Model 100 cannot accept a VPT or a Print-Out-Module. While this was the information which we had at the time of drafting the letter, the manufacturer later declared that the auxiliary devices could be accommodated (see CMC letter October 2, 1973). Our Approval Notice G-104 issued on November 27, 1973 did state that the Model 100 could accept the auxiliary devices but no specific cancellation of the previous statement was issued;
- (ii) the illustrations in G-104 are all headed "Canadian Meter Company, Base Volume Index Continuous Integrators, Models 100 and 200" while in fact the one on page 2 shows Model 100 only, the one on page 6 shows the Model 200 only, and the ones on pages 10, 11, 12 and 13 show the Model 100 only.
