MODIFICATION OF TYPE APPROVALPARKINSON & COWAN TYPES "D-1" AND "D-1A"
POSITIVE DISPLACEMENT GAS METERS


The modification to the apparatus specified herein has been duly approved by the Standards Division under the provisions of the Gas Inspection Act, Chapter 129, R.S. 1952, and the modified apparatus may be admitted to verification in Canada.


Apparatus Modified: Types "D-1" and "D-1A" Positive Displacement Gas Meters, manufactured by Parkinson & Cowan (Gas Meters) Limited, London, England, and assembled in Canada by Hamer Meter Company, Toronto, Ontario.

Rating of Apparatus: As previously approved - see Circular Letters:-
SD-GA.4, dated June 8, 1950
SD-GA.14, dated April 28, 1952
SD-GA.44, dated July 3, 1953.

Modification: The modification consists of a circular hand-hole cut in the top of the meter cover. A circular sheet metal cover is soldered in place to close the hand-hole.

Conditions: The ordinary sealing ring must be so placed as to seal both the hand-hole and the cover.
