

temperature of the tank water, and both are fully saturated by the tank water. This assures calorimeter readings entirely independent of changes in atmospheric pressure, temperature, or humidity, and no corrections for these variables are required. The recorder, adapted to the exacting requirements of calorimetry, is driven by a synchronous motor, insuring perfect chart timing.

The Type "Elektronik" calorimeter is supplied with a Brown Elektronik "Continuous Balance" unit.
