## NOTIFICATION OF TYPE LISTING

Under the provisions of the appropriate Act the apparatus specified and illustrated herein has been listed as a Class A device, and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable to this classification.

Authority: Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 212, R.S. 1927, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 3459).

Apparatus Listed: Model GB Counter-Computing-Platform-Fan Chart Scale, manufactured by Berkel Products Company, Limited, Toronto, Ont.

Rating of Apparatus: 40 lbs. maximum with 0 to 1 lb. on the chart.

Application: Weighing of commodities in general trade.

Conditions:- As prescribed in P.C. 3459.

Description:- The scale is a Counter-Computing-Platform-Fan Chart type, operated by a combination equal-arm balance-pendulum mechanism. The mechanism is provided with agate bearings and hardened steel knife-edges. The commodity platform has four point support. An oil dashpot, balance ball, levelling feet and alcohol level permit adjustment. The chart dial may face the commodity platter or be at right angles to it. The weight chart is visible on both sides of the dial whereas the money chart is visible only on the merchant's side. The metal casings are finished in stainless steel and the platters in enamel.

Testing: The standard tests for a Counter-Computing-Platform-Fan Chart Scale will apply.
