## NOTIFICATION OF TYPE LISTING

Under the provisions of the appropriate Act, the apparatus specified and illustrated herein has been listed as a Class A device, and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions stated herein.

Authority: Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 212, R.S. 1927, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 3459).

Apparatus Listed: Model 673 Prepackaging Scale (Dayton), manufactured by The Hobart Manufacturing Company, Limited, Toronto, Ontario.


Rating of Apparatus: 30 lbs. maximum capacity.

Application: Weighing of commodities for prepackaging purposes.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 3459 with the added mandatory requirement that this scale shall not be used on the retail premises of any business enterprise; and that one or more metal plugs be provided.

Description: This scale is a counter-computing-platform-cylindrical chart type, incorporating special features suiting it to prepackaging use. It has a spring and lever type of mechanism and hardened steel bearings. A manual tare adjusting knob, zero adjusting knob, levelling feet, and a thermostatically controlled, oil dashpot are provided. The chart cylinder is mounted on a high column and the chart is arranged for straight reading, on the operator's side only, through magnifying lens and a manually operated magniscope which focusses the selected price. Optional charts may have 12 lb., 18 lb., or 24 lb. capacity. The commodity platform has four point support and is finished in porcelain enamel and the housings in grey morocco.

Testing: The standard tests for a counter-computing-platform-cylindrical chart scale will apply.
