NOTIFICATION OF TYPE LISTING

Under the provisions of the appropriate Act, the apparatus specified and illustrated herein have been listed as Class A devices, and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions stated herein.

Authority: Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 212, R.S. 1927 and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 3459).

Apparatus Listed: Models 11, 11A, 11B, 11C, and 11D Counter-Computing-Platform-Fan Chart Scale, manufactured by Swift and Swallow (Canada) Limited, Toronto, Ont.


Rating of Apparatus: 2 lb., 3 lb., 3 lb., 4 lb., and 4 lb. maximum capacity respectively.

Application: Weighing of commodities in general trade.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 3459.

Description: The weighing mechanism of these scales consists of a counter-weighted unequal arm beam balanced on hardened steel knife-edges and agate bearings. Similar knife-edges and bearings are used at all pivots. An adjustable pointer resistant, adjustable feet, spirit level and an oil dashpot are provided and the latter is reached through a covered aperture in the front end of the casing. The chart dial may face the commodity platter or be set at right angles to it. The mechanism and dial are encased in porcelain-finished metal. Metal scoops, pans and platters are optional equipment.

Testing: The standard tests for a counter-computing-platform fan chart scale will apply.
