## NOTIFICATION OF TYPE LISTING

Bench Type Platform Scale - Manufactured by the  
Fairbanks-Morse Co. Ltd., St. Johnsbury, Vermont, U.S.A.

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein have been listed as approved devices and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.


**Apparatus Listed:** Portable type bench scales, Models 12008, 12006, and 12122 with capacities of 31 lbs. x  $\frac{1}{4}$  ounce, 300 lbs. x 4 ounces, and 100 lbs. x 1 ounce, respectively.


**Application:** Weighing commodities in trade, shipping, warehouse weighing and industrial use.

**Conditions:** As prescribed in P.C. 6894. These devices must be equipped with a balance ball on the beam and a zero balance stop for the tare poise.

**Description:** These devices are bench scales equipped with a two bar weighbeam and are manufactured of pressed and welded steel. The Model 12008 has the beam located on the side of the scale and below the level of the load receiving element. The leverage system of this model consists of two A type welded steel bar levers with a diagonal arm welded to one of the A levers and transmitting power to the beam connecting rod. The load bearings are V notched hardened steel blocks loosely pinned in place to make them self aligning. Pivots are pear shaped with turned shanks and are pressed in. The balance ball is of the split locking nut type. The Models 12006 and 12122 are similar in general design characteristics to Model 12008, except that the beam is located above the load receiving element and is supported by a pressed steel pillar at one end of the scale. The casings of all models are manufactured of pressed steel plate.

**Testing:** The standard tests for a platform scale shall apply.

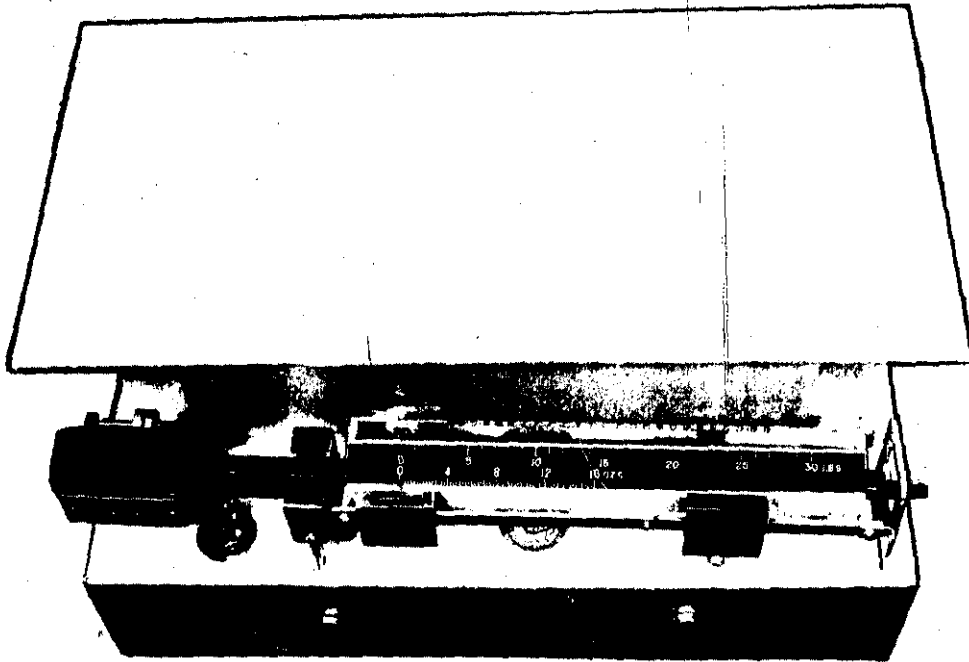
