Parcel Post Counter Scale, Manufactured by
Gurney Scale Co. Limited, Hamilton, Ontario.

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein has been listed as an approved device and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.


Apparatus Listed: Counter platform scale model 000 with a capacity of 25 lbs.


Application: Parcel Post weighing

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894

Description: This device is an unequal arm platform counter scale with two brass beam bars fastened to the cast iron beam butt with screws. The front beam is graduated to 9 lbs. x 1 oz. and is equipped with a cast iron sliding poise. The rear beam is notched and graduated to 16 lbs. x 8 lbs. and is equipped with a cast iron poise. Pivots are pear shaped hardened steel and bearings are chilled cast iron provided with dust caps. The load receiving element is stabilized and a balancing shot pot is provided in the bridging below the platter.

Testing: The Standard tests for a counter platform scale shall apply.
