Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein has been listed as an approved device and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Rating of Apparatus: 210 feet per minute. Maximum diameter capacity 1 inch.

Application: Linear measuring of wire and cordage for trade.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894.

Description: This device consists of two metal drums, one is an idler under spring tension and the other is a measuring drum geared to a counting head which registers feet and inches. A compound inlet guide tube provides inlet tubes of 1/2" and 1". A spring tension release is provided. Reference point for measurement is the outer edge of the exit guide. The counting head is returned to zero manually.

Testing: The standard tests for a drum type linear measuring device shall apply.
