The apparatus specified and illustrated herein have been duly approved under the provisions of the appropriate Act, and may be admitted to verification in Canada.

Apparatus Approved:- Models 70 and 100-B Computing Gasoline Pumps, manufactured by The Wayne Pump Company, Toronto, Ontario.


Rating of Apparatus:- 15 gallons per minute.

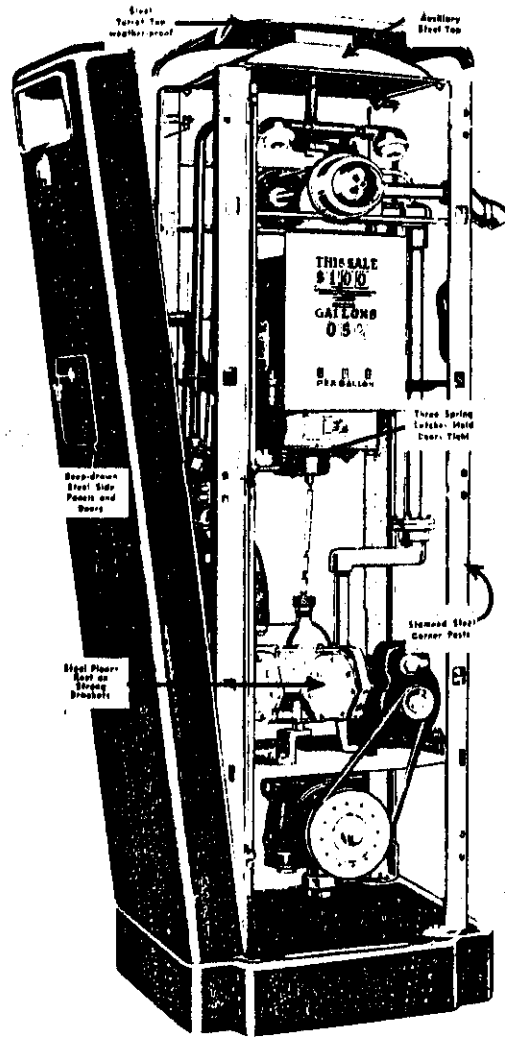
Application:- Retail gasoline trade.

Description: The components of these models consist of motor-driven pump, strainer, air separator, meter and Vooder-Root computing head. The meter is a four-cylinder positive displacement type, with registration adjustment by means of a micrometer screw limiting the throw of one of the pistons. Sealing facilities, preventing access to this adjustment, are provided. The 100-B differs from the Model 70 only in the closer assembly required to fit into the low style chassis.

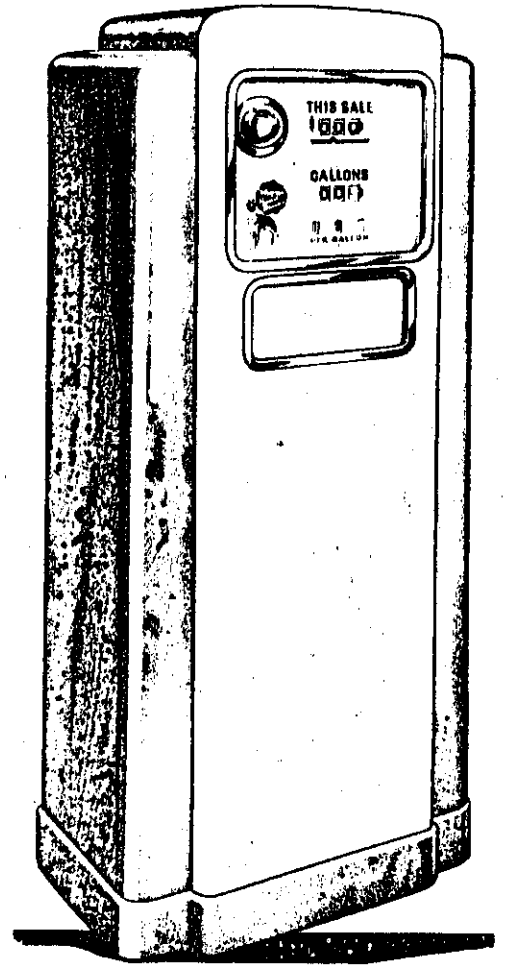
Testing:- The standard tests for computing gasoline pumps will apply.
