## NOTIFICATION OF TYPE LISTING

Under the provisions of the appropriate Act the apparatus specified and illustrated herein has been listed as a Class A device, and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable to this classification.

Authority: Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 212, R.S. 1927 and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 3459).

Apparatus Listed: Model 4039-2 Flight-Fueler (Gasoline Pumping Unit), manufactured by Erie Meter Systems, Incorporated, Erie, Pennsylvania.


Rating of Apparatus: 16 gallons per minute.

Application: Retail gasoline trade (primarily aircraft fueling).

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 3459 and provided that the unit is equipped with a register interlocking device, water separator located ahead of the meter, and is marked in units of Dominion Measure (Imperial).

Description: The Model 4039-2 unit is a modification of the Erie Model 4010 Flight-Fueler and consists of an electric motor-driven gasoline pump equipped with an air eliminator; a water separator located ahead of the meter; a non-computing type of rotary register provided with an interlocking device; a hose reel; synthetic rubber aircraft-type refuelling hose and a brass, aircraft-type, refuelling nozzle; and housed in an all-steel, paint finished, steel cabinet.

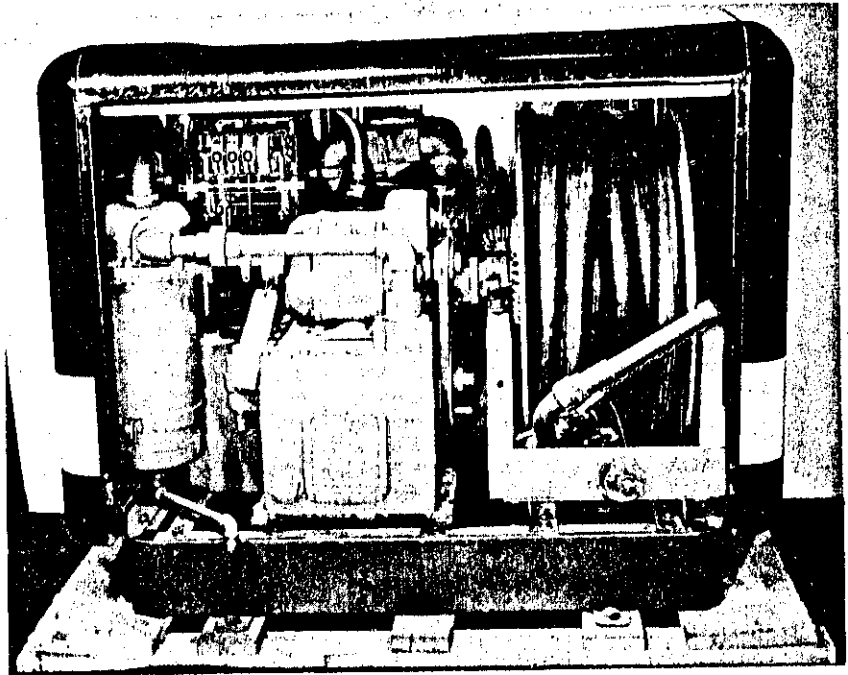
Testing: The standard tests for a gasoline pump will apply.
