NOTIFICATION OF TYPE LISTING

Under the provisions of the appropriate Act, the apparatus specified herein has been listed as a Class A device, and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable to this classification.

Authority: Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 212, R.S. 1927, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 3459).

Apparatus Listed: Type (P) Model 2000, Motor Truck Dormant Platform Scale equipped with either (C) or (D) model weighbeams, manufactured by Winslow Government Standard Scale Works, Inc., Terre Haute, Indiana. The (C) model weighbeam is a Capacity beam with fractional bar. The (D) model beam is a Compound beam with main and tare bars and also two fractional bars.

Rating of Apparatus: 12 ton, 15 ton, 18 ton, 20 ton and 25 ton.

Application: To weigh merchandise carrying vehicles.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 3459.

Description: The Type (P) truck scale is of torsion lever design with side arms which connect with a common linkage attached to the steelyard rod. This scale is designed for installation in a shallow pit. The torque tube and pivot housings are cast in one piece and the side arms are keyed and bolted to a boss on the torque tube extension. The platform is checked longitudinally and transversely by means of rollers which lie in grooved plates immediately above the main bearings. Both load and fulcrum bearings are semi-floating.

Testing: The standard tests for a motor truck scale will apply.
