NOTIFICATION OF TYPE LISTING

Under the provisions of the appropriate Act, the apparatus specified and illustrated herein has been listed as a Class A device, and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable to this classification.

Authority: Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 212, R.S. 1927, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 3459).

Apparatus Listed: Models 500 and 505 computing gasoline meter pumps, manufactured by The Wayne Pump Company, Toronto, Ontario.

Rating of Apparatus: 15 gallons per minute.


Application: Retail gasoline trade.


Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 3459.

Description: The operating mechanism of both models is similar in basic design to Model 100B listed on Circular SD-WA.8, except that the air eliminator has been redesigned to the extent that an additional float unit has been added and the pumping unit bearings have been replaced by ball bearings.

The two models differ in that the Model 505 has the long hose supported externally when not in use and the Model 500 is equipped with a weight mechanism which draws the unused portion of hose within the casing of the pump.

Testing: The standard tests for a computing meter pump shall apply.
