NOTIFICATION OF TYPE LISTING

Under the provisions of the appropriate Act, the apparatus specified herein have been listed as Class A devices, and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable to this classification.

Authority: Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 212, R.S. 1927, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 3459).

Apparatus Listed: Models 746, 756, 766 and 646 Computing Gasoline Meter Pumps, and Models 757, 767 and 647 Non-computing Gasoline Meter Pumps, manufactured by the John Wood Co. Limited, 101 Hanson Avenue, Toronto, Ontario.

The meter pumps listed have previously been manufactured by the Service Station Equipment Co., Toronto, Ontario.

Rating of Apparetus: 13.5 gallons per minute.

Application: Retail gasoline trade.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 3459.

Description: Models 746, 756 and 766 have been listed on Circulars SD-WA.22 and SD-WA.43. Models 757 and 767 are the same basic design as 756 and 766 respectively except that 757 and 767 are Non-computing. Models 647 and 646 are the same fundamental design as Model 746 except that the mechanisms are installed in casings of greater height and Model 647 is equipped with Non-computing head. The Models 647 and 646 have been in production for five years.

Testing: The standard tests for a gasoline meter pump shall apply.
