APPROVAL LISTING

Retail Gasoline Dispensing Meters - Manufactured by the Tokheim Corporation, Fort Wayne, Indiana, U.S.A.

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein have been listed as approved devices and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: Computing gasoline dispensing meter pumps, Models 39A (single dispenser), 39A-1 (twin dispenser), and 39A-2 (twin dispenser).

Rating of Apparatus: 12 gallons per minute.

Application: Retail gasoline trade.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894, with the added requirement that all hose nozzles be equipped with automatic check valves in addition to the manually operated delivery valve.

Description: These devices are similar to the gasoline dispensing meter pump Model 39L-RA listed on SD-WA. 102, except for the following changes:

- The same components are used in the meter pump assembly, but they have been re-arranged for better accessibility.
- (2) Model 39A-1 is a twin meter pump composed of two 39A Models in separate casings, but joined mechanically and having only one gasoline inlet line for delivering one type of gasoline to both meters.
- (3) Model 39A-2 is identical with Model 39A-1, except that each pump has a separate inlet line for delivering a different type of gasoline to each meter.

Testing: The standard tests for a gasoline dispensing meter pump shall apply.
