Gasoline Dispenser with Remote Pumping Unit -  
Manufactured by Gilbert and Barker Manufacturing  
Company, 64 Jefferson Avenue, Toronto, Ont.

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act,  
Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the  
apparatus specified and illustrated herein has been listed as an approved  
device and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applic-  
able.

Apparatus Listed: Retail computing gasoline dispenser, Model  
G-906 ARG.

Rating of Apparatus: 10 gallons per minute.


Application: Retail gasoline trade.


Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894.

Description: This device is a gasoline dispenser of the computing  
type and is similar to Model G-906 listed on SD-WA.160,  
in that the meter, registering head, visiglass and hose  
are assembled in the same manner and the parts are  
identical.

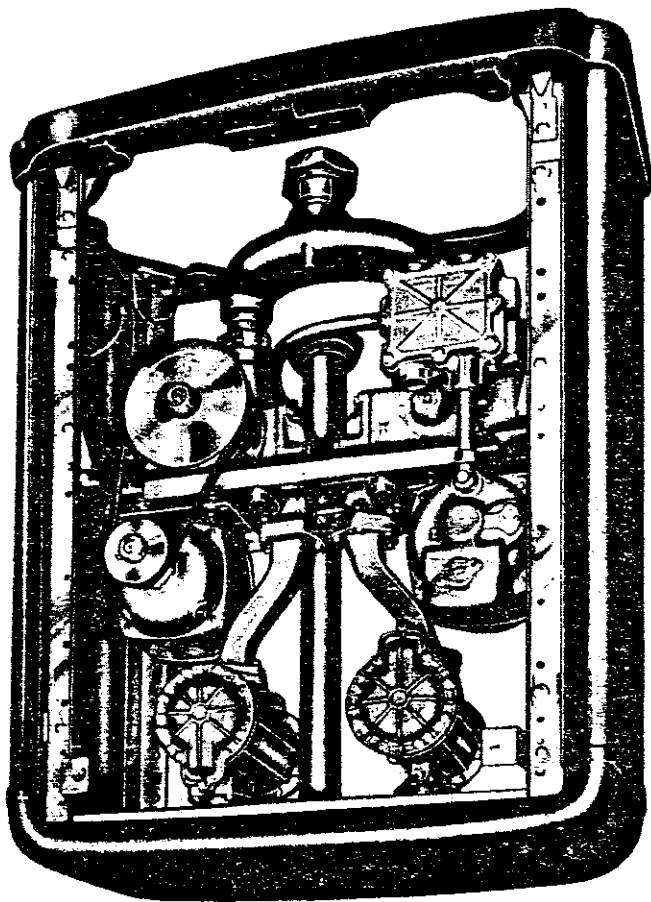
The motor pump and air eliminator have been removed  
and replaced by a dual assembly consisting of 2 motors,  
2 pumps and 2 air eliminators, installed in a separate  
cabinet, Model ROP 400, located above or near the  
gasoline storage tank. This unit may pump gasoline to  
a single dispenser or two or more dispensers simultane-  
ously.

Testing: The standard tests for a retail gasoline dispenser shall

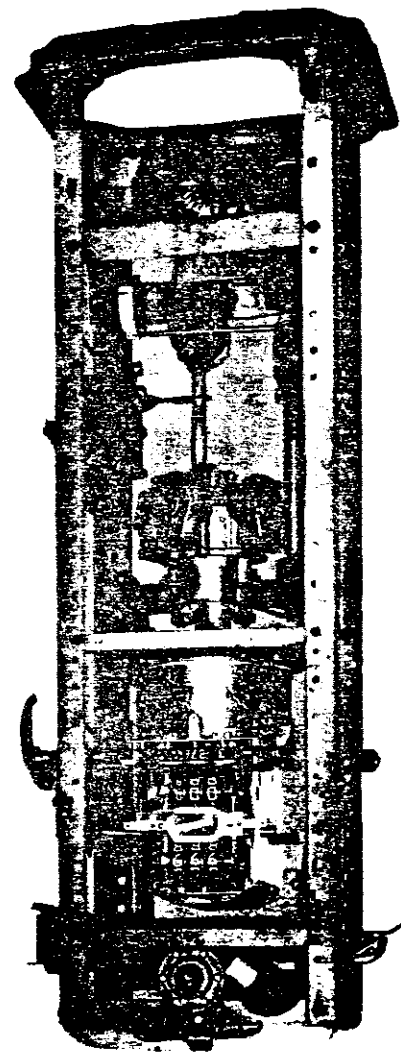
