Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein have been listed as approved devices and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: Computing gasoline dispenser, Models 585-C and 595-C.

Description: These devices are similar in general design to models

577TV and 577TVC listed on SD-WA.219 except that: (i) The air separator is located on the top of the meter (ii) The float chamber is a separate unit

(iii) The pump manifold has been changed.




