APPROVAL LISTING

Bulk Neter Pump - Manufactured by Gilbert and Barker Manufacturing Company, 829 Richmond Street West, Toronto 1, Ontario.

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein have been listed as approved devices and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: Bulk meter pump, Models CFP201 and CFP202 with capacities of

13 G.P.M. and 18 G.P.M.

NOTE: These model numbers may be followed by the letter D and numbers one to six. This suffix denotes electrical

characteristics of the motor.

Application: Metering wholesale quantities of gasoline or other petroleum products

for which it is calibrated.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894, with the added mandatory requirement that

a metal plate be permanently affixed to the casing immediately below the registering head, in view of the customer and bearing the words:-

NOT LEGAL FOR DELIVERY OF QUANTITIES UNDER 40 GALLONS

The words: RESET COUNTER TO ZERO BEFORE EACH DELIVERY must appear

either on the counter or on the above-mentioned plate.

Description: These devices are meter pumps equipped with a non computing bulk

meter type registering head and may be equipped with a printer. The mechanism is not equipped with an interlocking device as required on retail meter pumps. The metering unit is similar to that used on Gilbert and Barker meter pumps generally and a cylindrical sight glass is installed outside the meter casing on the discharge line.

Testing: The standard tests for a meter pump shall apply as a preliminary test

and in addition, consecutive 5 gallon test runs shall be made to at least a total of 40 gallons and the accumulated error compared with

the toleration of .25% in excess or deficiency.
