APPROVAL LISTING

Gescline dispenser, commercial type with remote pump -Manufactured by Eris Noter Systems Inc., Eris 6, Pa.

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein has been listed as an approved device and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: Gasoline dispenser with non computing reset registering head or reset counter and printer and is equipped with a remote pumping unit. Model 935 with maximum capacity of 15 G.P.M.

Application: (1) For use in general trade: Device must be equipped with interlocking device. (2) For use in wholesale trade (deliveries of 40

gallons or more). Interlocking device is not required.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894 with the following requirements mandatory: (a) When device is equipped for general trade use, a plate is to be

permanently affixed to the casing below the register bearing the

legend - "Legal for delivery - This side only".

(b) When device is equipped for wholesale use only, a plate is to be permanently affixed to the casing below the register bearing the legend - "Not legal for delivery of quantities under 40 gallons".

Description: This device is a non computing gasoline dispenser equipped with the same meter and remote pumping unit (Series 776 or Turbine type) as meter pump Model 745 listed on SD-WA.253. The interlooking device provided, interlocks the counting mechanism with the motor switch and the switch controls the opening and closing of a valve on the inlet

side of the meter. The casing is the low commercial type with the counter set on top of the housing and the discharge hose is looped

around the device.

Testing: The standard tests for a meter pump shall apply. When used as a wholesale pump, quantities up to at least 40 gallons should be withdrawn and the volume checked.
