Oil dispensing meter - manufactured by Stewart Warner Corp. of Canada Limited, Belleville, Ontario.

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act. Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein have been listed as approved devices and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applieable.

Apparatus Listed: Oil dispensing meters, models 3682B and 3683B.

Rating:

Four pints per minute.

Application:

Metering gear oil with viscosities, of S.A.E. 80 & S.A.E.90

Conditions:

As prescribed in P.C. 6894. It is required that the meter be provided with means for sealing and provision made on the meter to receive the inspector's stamp mark.

Description:

These devices are oil meters of the same basic design as model 3689C (SD-WA. 281) with the following exceptions:

(1) The dial is graduated to 8 pints by 2 pint graduations and

has a single indicator.

(2) Model 3683B in addition to the dial is equipped with a

nom-reset totalizar.

The nozzle and flow control handle although functionally

the same has been redesigned.

(4) The pump supplied was operated with air pressure.

Testing:

The standard tests for a small capacity meter shall apply.






