ERIE GASOLINE DISPENSERS
840 SERIES WITH REMOTE PUMP

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein have been listed as approved devices and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: Computing gasoline dispenser Models 842-16, 845-16 and 849-16.,
Twin computing dispenser Model 240-5-16, manufactured by Erie Meter
Systems Inc., Erie, Penna. U.S.A.


Rating of Apparatus: 10 G.P.M. to 15 G.P.M. maximum capacity depending on pump
used and number of meters on line.


Application: Retail gasoline trade.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894.

Description: These devices are gasoline dispensers equipped with remote pumping
units and with similar components and piping layout as dispensers
listed on SD-WA.253, except that the Veeder-Root registering head
is equipped with larger figures and a semi automatic register set
back. These dispensers may be equipped with remote cabinet or
chassis type pump Models 776-10, 776-30, 776-20, 776, submerged
turbine pump 4600-10 series or "Removo" submersible pump series 300.
Minor changes have been incorporated in the cabinet such as a redesigned
register window.

Testing: The standard tests for a retail gasoline dispenser shall apply.
