TOKHEIM GASOLINE DISPENSERS MODELS 350-1 and 350-2

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act., Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein have been listed as approved devices and may be used in Camada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: Twin computing gasoline dispensers, Models 350-1 (one product) and 350-2 (two product) manufactured by Tokheim Corporation, Fort Wayne, Indiana, U.S.A.

Rating of Apparatus: 12 C.P.M. each unit.

Application: Retail Gasoline trade.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 8894.

. Description: These devices are twin dispensers encased in a single cabinet. Model 350-1 is a one product type with one 2" suction line manifolded to each pump. Kodel 350-2 is a two product dispenser with two 1 $1/2^n$ suction lines each leading to a separate pump and metering unit. In both models the components and general layout are the same as Model 300 listed on SD-WA. 284 except that the Veeder-Root counter is a new model with semi automatic set back and the figures of the register are larger.

Testing: The standard tests for a gasoline dispenser shall apply.
